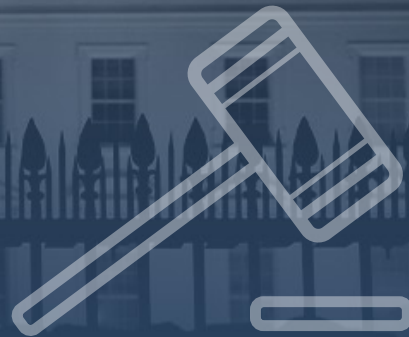


The Republican Commitment to

Ensure Faith in Our Free and Fair Elections and Restore the People's Voice

Democrats have sought to undermine the constitutional principle of one-person, one-vote by rejecting Republicans' focus on strong reforms designed to bolster voter confidence and strengthen our electoral system. In the House, Democrats have silenced the people's voice through proxy voting and eliminated minority rights.

Early voting in Georgia in 2022 came in at nearly **triple** Georgia's 2018 level

90% of House Democrats have gotten paid while not showing up in-person

Republicans will maintain a government of the people, by the people:

- 1. End proxy voting so Members of Congress need to show up to vote to get paid**
- 2. Ensure safe and fair elections** through voter ID, accurate voter rolls, and observer access
- 3. Prevent non-citizens from participating in our elections**

1 Celebrate America

- Identify community members who want to rally around the privilege of living in the United States of America
- Elevate voices who can speak firsthand to the importance of freedom and democracy - because they have lived through the alternative
- For example, last summer House Republicans traveled to Miami, FL to stand in solidarity with the Cuban people as they cried out for liberty from communism. They listened to their stories at roundtable events and participated in a Cuba Freedom Rally to show their support



2 Defend our Troops and Veterans

- Host a conversation with veterans in your community to discuss the consequences of the Biden administration's reckless and haphazard decision-making
- On the anniversary of the fall of Kabul, honor those who were killed in action and the Gold Star families that tragically resulted from this loss of life
- For example, last summer House Republicans held a roundtable with Members of Congress who have graciously served their country to hear their take on the disastrous withdrawal



3 Protect the People's House

- Remind your constituents that House Republicans are committed to accountability - and for fighting to protect the People's House, not Pelosi's House
- Find voices in your communities who are vocal about their disappointment in House Democrats' willingness to permanently damage our institutions - through proxy voting and changing the rules to benefit themselves
- For example, when Speaker Pelosi attempted to disenfranchise the voters in Iowa's second congressional district, House Republicans spoke up about this behavior being antithetical to our democracy, and met with concerned constituents to hear their opinions about Democrats' intentions to unseat a duly-elected Representative
