

## Ice Cream Cones enhanced with the app Percolator

Time: Three or Four-60 minute classes

Ice Cream Cone Painting (2-3 classes):

- Draw a cone and 4 scoops on separate pieces of paper.
- Choose one paint color and paint the cone and scoops with a different tint or shade by mixing the color with black or white, let dry.
- Using a small spray bottle with water color paints inside, the students sprayed a 6"x18" piece of white paper with 2 colors, let dry.
- Cut out the cone and scoops and glue to the sprayed white paper in graduated order.

Enhancing with iPad App "Percolator" (1 class)

- Each student had their own iPad with the app Percolator installed on it. The Percolator app is \$2.99 per device.
- First the students took a photo of their ice cream artwork with the iPads and cropped it.
- Second they opened the percolator app and loaded the photo onto it.
- Then we experimented with each filter "Grind", "Brew", and "Serve" to add different effects to the artwork.
- Once students were happy with their artwork, they saved the art to the iPad then emailed it to me from the camera roll.
