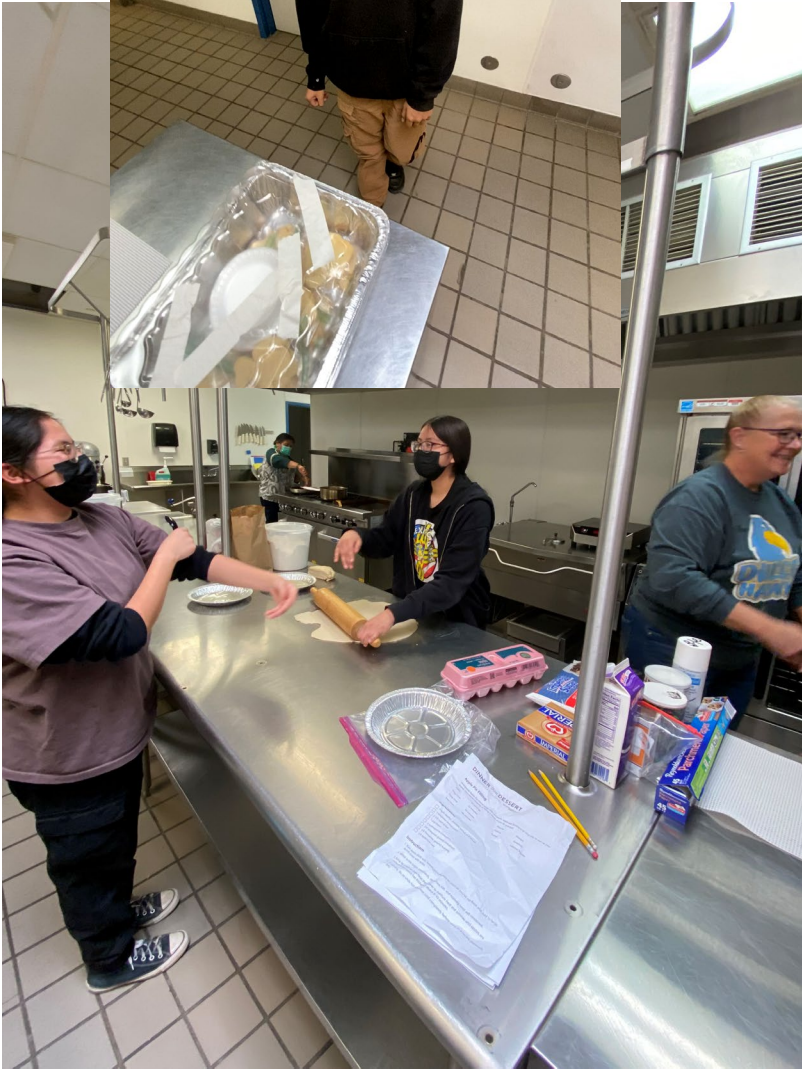

Made breakfast for the staff and students.



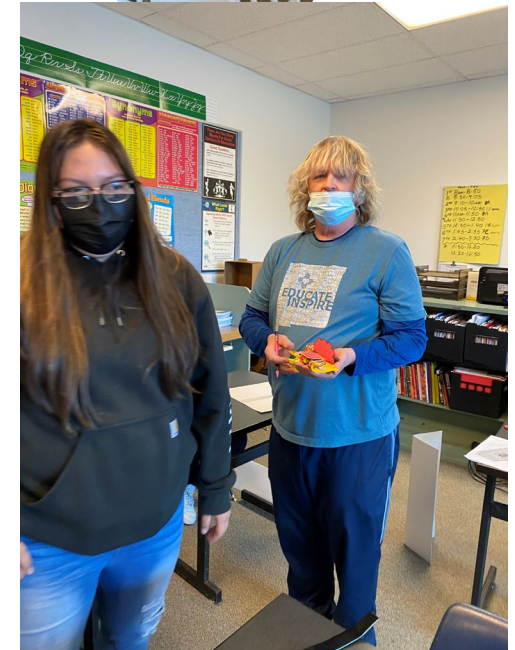

Made pies and scones.



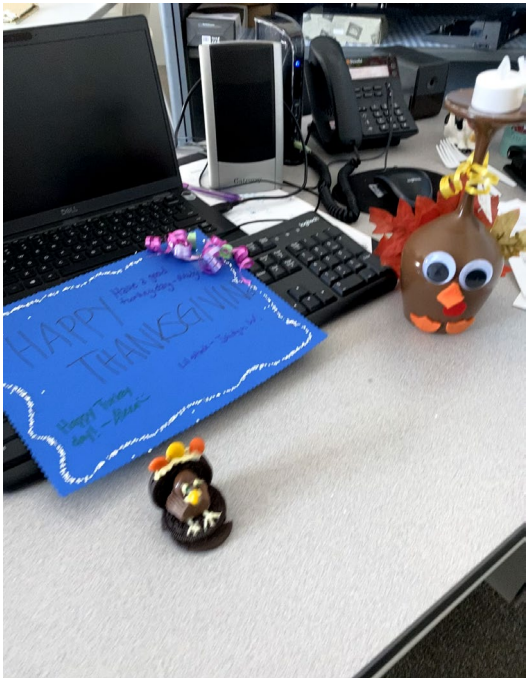
OCTOBER:
