Artistic Staff



Christina Hampton (Artistic Director) began her ballet career training in Belgium from Bejart soloist, Daniel Lambo. She also trained at Tidewater Ballet, Virginia State Ballet and Star Dancer's Ballet in Tokyo, Japan. She was a full scholarship recipient at Chicago City Ballet School under Marjorie Tallchief Skibine and her sister Maria Tallchief. Christina spent two summers at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet (CPYB) where she later became a permanent Summer Guest Faculty member for over 20 years. She began her professional career in 1986 with Tampa Ballet. In 1987, she became principal dancer with Minnesota Ballet where she performed roles such as Odette/ Odile, Aurora and Swanhilda. In 1996, she was principal guest artist with Santa Barbara's State Street Ballet and the following year with Hartford Ballet under Artistic Director, KirkPeterson. She spent the last eight years of her twenty-year career as principal dancer with Ballet Florida. She performed in works by Glen Tetley, Val Caniparoli, Lar Lubovitch, Sean Lavery, Ben Stevenson, Jerome Robbins and Twyla Tharp. Christina Hampton has been teaching for over 40 years and her affiliations have included Chicago City Ballet School, School of Minnesota Ballet, School of Ballet Florida and she was Guest Instructor at Brigham Young University in 2019.



Scott Bodily (Ballet Master) has a diverse background as a professional dancer, singer, choreographer and performer, and is a founding member of the renowned Utah Festival Opera and Musical Theater. Scott possesses an MFA in Dance and a BS in Psychology. His Professional performance credits include local, national and international works in Classical Ballet, Modern, Broadway National Tour, Opera, Cruise Lines and other crossgenre engagements. Scott is persistently active in mentoring young artists, pre-professionals, college students and has developed a proven teaching pedagogy. His choreographic works include Musical Theater, Classical Ballet, Contemporary, Modern, Jazz, Opera and have been performed by Utah Festival Opera and Musical Theater, Center Dance Ensemble, Arizona Youth Ballet, Dayton Ballet II, various colleges and universities dance and theater departments including Mesa Community College, Scottsdale Community College, Chandler-Gilbert Community College, Sam Houston State University and Utah State University. His works have been presented at American Voices, Kick=A, Arizona Youth Artists Competition and selected multiple times to appear in Dance in the Desert Festival (Las Vegas) and Harvest Chicago Festival (Chicago)






