
A lot of people have gotten sick with something called Coronavirus or COVID-19.




Doctors and nurses are working hard to help people with Coronavirus feel better.




Coronavirus germs can spread very easily!

Some masks have fun designs on them!




Some masks are like bandanas or scarves!




Some masks are even made from socks!

I need to wear a mask, too.




My mask needs to cover my nose and mouth. This keeps my germs in and other germs out!




The mask might feel a little silly, funny, or scary on my face at first.
