SMALL BATCH WINES ON TAP

'18 Biohof Pratsch, Grüner Veltliner, Niederösterreich, Austria 9 glass

The most widely planted grape in Austria. Food friendly, slightly herbal, fresh, and spicy with notes of pear, lime, and sweet tart on the palate. Certified Organic

'16 Ti Amo, Barbera, Provincia di Pavia, Lombardi, Italy 9 glass

This is a beautifully bright fruit forward Barbera that has delightful aromas of cherries and raspberries and a subtly dry finish

BUBBLES

By The Glass

NV Lamberti, Extra Dry, Prosecco D.O.C., Veneto, Italy 37 bottle / 9 glass

100% Glera. Floral notes of peach and tropical fruit make this a lively and effervescent gem! The palate is clean and crisp with balanced acidity and a lingering finish

NV Jaillance, 'Cuvée de l'Abbaye' Rosé, Crémant de Bordeaux, France 48 bottle / 12 glass

Delicate salmon-pink with Champagne-style Merlot with a nose of strawberries & cream

NV Castell de Sant Pau, Brut Nature, Cava, Spain 46 bottle / 11 glass

This lovely, crisp and refreshing bubbly is made in the trendy style of the most sought-after grower champagnes: with no dosage, or added sugar (thus the "brut nature" nomenclature). This is yet another example of why cava is a favorite sparkling wine for budget-conscious wine lovers

More Bubbles

NV Charles Sparr, Cremant de Loire, Brut Sparkling, Loire, France 46

A restrained nose gives way to softly etched notes of fruit, hinting at apple, lemon and biscuit. This is mild but dry, easy but elegant, understated but very refreshing. It's an ideal apéritif

NV, Besserat De Bellefon, Grande Tradition Brut, Epernay, Champagne, France 90 *dine-in only

Made from Chardonnay (45%), Pinot Noir (35%) and Pinot Meunier (20%), this champagne has been aged for 3 years. Known for uniquely small bubbles, this Champagne has a creamy character and freshness underlined by a defined acidity and radiance. Floral aromas of rose petals are subtle and elegant, followed by an attack on the palate that is fresh and balanced, delivering notes of red fruits (strawberry) in harmony with fragrances of honey. The finish is long and fleshy, a sign of a full and well-balanced wine

ROSÉ

'17 Bodegas Breca, Rosé, D.O. Calatayud, Spain 39 bottle / 10 glass

100% Garnacha de Aragón, the oldest clone of Garnacha (Grenache) in the world. Beautiful aroma of ripe cherries and sweet spices compliment bright acidity and richness on the finish

'19 B&G "Tourmaline", Cotes de Provence Rosé, France 56 bottle / 14 glass

Seductive and delicate with aromas of ripe red berries and white flowers. An explosion of fruit with a nice freshness throughout the finish

More Rosé

'19 Maris, Rosé, Pays d'Oc, France 44

Made with organic grapes grown in an environment promoting biodiversity and sustainability - from a Top 5 Sustainable Winery in the world (made completely of hemp and carbon negative). Subtle and balanced, elegant and tasty, floral and fruity, fresh and round, with orange and raspberry notes and balanced minerality

'17 Bove, 'Avegiano', Cerasuolo D'Abruzzo, Italy 48

Cherry colored dry rosé is made from Montepulciano with appealing aromas of wild strawberry and raspberry. Fresh, well-structured, and nice acidity support soft redcurrant and cherry fruit flavors that linger

ORANGE WINE

'20 Field Recordings, "SKINS" Orange Wine, Paso Robles, California 58 bottle / 15 glass

This crisp orange wine is a blend of 41% Chenin Blanc 37% Pinot Gris, 9% Albariño, 89% Verdelho, 5% Riesling and is perfect to pair with spicy foods, springtime and ... well, anything! The fruit is destemmed and sits on-the-skins for anywhere from 60 to 90 days and delivers flavors and aromas of apricot, Haitian orange, and marzipan with subtle texture

WHITES

By The Glass

'20 Bodega Garzón, Albariño, Garzón, Uruguay 48 bottle / 12 glass

From the top winery in Uruguay! 100% Albariño and aged on the lees in stainless steel tanks, this lively wine offers aromas and flavors of peach and citrus, delivering freshness and minerality on the mid-palate, with remarkable acidity and a round, crisp, finish

'18 Famille Thomas, "Les Créots", Sancerre, Loire Valley, France 60 bottle / 16 glass

100% Sauvignon Blanc. White flowers, yellow straw and lemon peel aromas and flavors. Nice weight and depth on the palate with lees-enriched complexity, good focus, and vibrant acidity, with a chalky mineral tone throughout. Beautifully food friendly

'16 Miner Family Vineyards, Chardonnay, Napa, California 15 glass

From a stellar Napa winery, this reserve-style chardonnay delivers with flavors and aromas of crisp apple, ripe melon and citrus gently balanced with toasty French oak. Aged 10 Months on 30% new French oak and 40% stainless steel, with 50% malolactic fermentation. A real treat!

'18 Carlo Deltetto, "San Michele, Arneis, Roero", Piedmont Italy 56 bottle / 14 glass Pale yellow color with notes of exotic fruit, apples, vanilla, and rich spice make this an elegant wine with a long and pleasing finish. Beautifully food-friendly, Roero Arneis is uniquely grown in the sandy soils of an ancient sea bed just 15 minutes north of Barbaresco. You need to discover this grape!

'16 Sorrentino, Vigna Lapillo, Lacryma Christi Del Vesuvio Bianco, Campagna, Italy 48 bottle / 12 glass

A beautiful blend of Falanghina and Coda di Volpe Bianca. Clean and fresh with a fruity finish, exhibiting notes of peach, plum, and apricot with a hint of butter, and balanced acidity

'18 Dopff Au Moulin, Pinot Blanc, Alsace, France 48 bottle / 12 glass

Aromas of pear, apple, and freshly baked bread with a touch of spice delight the nose, while those same flavors blend with a gentle minerality to satisfy the palate

More Whites

'18 Bernard Defaix, Les Hauts De Milly, Chablis Premier Cru, Cotes De Lechet, Chablis, Burgundy, France 67

From one of the steepest and stoniest Crus in Chablis, it exhibits telltale minerality with aromas of peach, apricot and wild flowers. On the palate, gentle but sophisticated fruit flavors mix with limestone aspects and slight hints of vanilla. The very complex finish suggests whispers of smoke and lime zest. Superb pairing w/oysters, and quite literally, Spring!

'16 Famille Hugel, "Classic" Riesling, Alsace, France 62

Glints of very ripe, juicy pear and clementine on the nose turn into aromatic mandarin on the lively, open and absolutely fruit-laden palate that has both the juiciness and tartness of ripe citrus. The finish is dry, clean, fresh and has a tropical echo

'20 Supernatural, Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand 66

Organic and biodynamic 100% Sauvignon Blanc. Smoke & spice, with elevated acid offset by a creamy-buttery texture and extra richness from lees contact. Slightly warmer and rounder than Marlborough with super low sulfites (30ppm). A dream

'18 Domaine Guillemard-Clerc, "Les Parties", Bourgogne Blanc, Burgundy, France 70

(Baby) Puligny-Montrachet!) Hand-harvested and sorted, pressed immediately, then put straight into 20% new Allier French Oak and held for 9 months. Juicy tropical notes combine with white flowers and minerals on the nose, giving way to laser-focused flavors of the same, along with green apple and lemongrass

'18 Morgan, "Highland" Chardonnay, Santa Lucia Highlands, California 56

Lemon custard, Nilla wafer, and sea spray aromas greet your senses and are complemented by a light touch of crème brûlée, graham cracker, and salted butter toffee on the palate. This incredibly food-friendly chardonnay is certified organic, and receives 33% new French oak and partial Malo-lactic fermentation, offering a creamy richness, balanced by bright acidity

'15 Bodegas Gancedo, "Capricho de Paxariñas", Godello, Bierzo, Spain 56

Small production, sustainable, blend of 85% Godello (25+ year old bush vines) and 15% Doña Blanca (60+ year old bush vines). Complex and fruit-driven with aromas of green olives, white flowers, and fresh fennel, with balanced acidity and a nutty dry finish

'18 Domaine Des Forges, "Le Moulin Du Due" Savennieres, Loire, France 55

100% Chenin Blanc! Honeyed aromas greet, while well-balanced acidity and minerality makes this a refreshing and food friendly wine. Dry, with notes of hazelnut, spice and fruit confit

REDS

By The Glass

'17 Pike Road, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon 54 bottle / 14 glass

Estate fruit is hand-picked & sorted, then aged 10 months in French Oak showing a pleasing bouquet of violets, cherries & cola. The fruit shines on the palate, with flavors of mixed red & blue berries. This one hits all the notes!

'18 Henri Latour, Hautes Cotes de Beaune, Bourgogne, France 68 bottle / 17 glass

A whisper of oak plays on the nose of this wine, accompanying black cherry, touches of cassis and savory notes of herbs and black truffles. Well-balanced acidity, along with tart cherry, and fine, soft tannins frame the palate and hold everything in an elegant embrace

'18 Au Bon Climat, Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara, California 62 bottle / 16 glass

Fantastic Santa Barbara fruit! Deeply colored with aromas and flavors of strawberries and raspberries joined by anise and clove in mouth filling intensity. Bring me more!

'18 Belasco De Baquedano, "Llama" Old Vine Malbec, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina 42 bottle / 11 glass

Fruity aromas of cherries, blackberries and plums stand out against a background toasty oak and leather. Warm, rounded, and well-structured on the palate, with an explosion of fruit flavors underscored a dry, elegant finish

'15 Mont-Redon, Reserve Cotes du Rhone, Rhone, France 52 bottle / 13 glass

Made of 80% Grenache & 20% Syrah, this classic CDR has a very expressive and complex nose with red fruit aromas. The mouth is rich with fine tannins and well structured cherry, plum, and chocolate, followed by a lightly spicy finish

'18 La Linda, Cabernet Sauvignon, Maipu, Mendoza, Argentina 52 bottle / 13 glass

From the exceptional vineyards of Luigi Bosca. High elevation (2500 Feet) old vine Cab expressing notes of blackberry, black pepper, and mulberry with a vibrant intensity and dry complexity. Aged 3 months in French and American Oak

'16 Garzón, Tannat Reserve, Garzón, Uruguay 52 bottle / 13 glass

A dark purple color and lush blackberry, cassis and woodspice aromas open this full-bodied Tannat with vibrancy. Toasty oak graces its core blackberry flavors, creating coffee and chocolate notes. On the finish, it's peppery, full and textured. Racy acidity balances fruit tannins, and are followed by a luxuriously old world finish. Medium bodied

'18 Mauritson, Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma, California 60 bottle / 15 glass

Black & red fruit jump out of the glass with notes of layered spice, leather, and anise on the palate. Sourced from estate and grower fruit including Rockpile Ridge. 14 months in oak (90% French)

'18 Goldschmidt Vineyards, "Katherine", Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, Sonoma, California 57 bottle / 15 glass

Ripe raspberries, black cherry and plum aromas with lush, ripe cherries and ripe blueberries on the front of the palate are followed by powerful, rich notes of dark plum and hints of chocolate. Supple round tannins lead to a long, elegant finish

More Reds

'16 Bodegas Altanza, "Capitosa", Rioja, Spain 40

100% Tempranillo. A delightful, fruity, and flavorful red exhibiting red berry, a hint of licorice, and a pleasing almond note on the finish. aged 6 months on oak casks

'17 Domaine des Coutures, "L'Épanouie" Saumur-Champigny, Loire, France 62

100% Cabernet Franc sustainably produced from 28-35 year old vines. Concentrated aromas and flavors of violets, leather, earth, dark cherry, and black licorice are balanced by elegant acidity and round supple tannins

'16 Domaine J. Boulon, Moulin A Vent, Cru Beaujolais, France 57

Deep garnet colored 100% Gamay with flavors of red berries, spice and neutral oak helps gives this wine a its Burgundian style

'18 Hèrencia Altés, Garnatxa Negra, Terra Alta, Spain 42

High elevation 40 to 100 year old vines, certified organic and hand-harvested, with 5 months in concrete tank. Deep, bright purple color. Strawberry and raspberry aromas mixed with hints of white pepper. A balance between fruit and mineral expression with a medium body and soft tannins. Food friendly and fun

'15 Tenuta Rapitala, Alto Nero D'Avola, Sicily, Italy 40

Opens with ripe plum, black-skinned berry and vanilla aromas. The medium-bodied palate shows blackberry jam, espresso and tobacco flavors while close-grained tannins give the finish grip. A delight!

'16 Château Petit-Freyton, "Cuvée Michael", Bordeaux, France 44

70% Cabernet Sauvignon 30% Merlot with blackberry, violets, and French oak aromas on the nose. Medium-bodied & dry with nice round tannins. Flavors of dark berry, dark chocolate, and smoke

RESERVE

'17 Weingut Pflüger, "Bio Dynamite" Riesling-Gewürtztraminer, Pfalz, Germany 74

From Bio-diversity pioneers in Pfalz (the "Tuscany of Germany") comes this certified biodynamic field blend of approximately 80% Riesling and 20% Gewürtztraminer. Wonderfully rich with floral notes and flavors of lemon, melon, litchi kept in check with moderate acidity and a generous mouthfeel. 500 cases produced. Electric!

RESERVE

'17 Pascal Jolivet, Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley, France 72

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Beautifully clear, with healthy and bright fruit aromas intertwined with refreshing citrus fruit notes on the nose. Round and juicy on the palate, this is a concentrated and firmly structured Pouilly with remarkably refreshing acidity and elegance. The wine is linear and has a stimulatingly salty finish. A treat

'10 Kesner, Chardonnay, Bacigalupi Vineyard, Russian River Valley, California 72

A stellar aged Chardonnay from Jason Kesner, exhibiting beautiful integration between French Oak and gentle fruit. Clean and slightly lighter on the palate, with subtle notes of lemon curd and baking spices. The vine-stock comes from the same fruit which won the 1976 Paris Competition when 1973 Napa Valley Chardonnay from Château Montelena triumphed over many acclaimed French wines. Singular

'15 Chateau Mont-Redon, Chateaneuf du Pape Blanc, Rhone, France 74

Fragrant, fruity and elegant blend of 60% Granache Blanc, 20% Clairette, 10% Roussanne, 5% Bourboulenc, and 5% Picpoul with notes of Key lime, pear and green apple. Crisp lemon flavors and white-blossom notes lend an invigorating feel to its bright and fresh expression, and an exquisite honeyed mineral finish delights. Like a dream

'17 Paul Hobbs, Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California 96

Aromas of dark cherry, tobacco, and cola meet flavors of plum and boysenberry, with notes of truffle and forest floor. Plush, rich, and... pure Russian River Valley.

'15, Château Siran, "S de Siran", Margaux, Bordeaux, France 74

A beautiful blend of 46% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc, the "deuxième vin" of Siran, produced with some 1st selection fruit. Dried violet petals on the nose and a full and smooth texture on the palate, with lots of blackberry and blueberry character. Aged 12 months in 15% new French Oak. Like velvet

'15 Jehan Emonin, "Santenots", Volnay Premier Cru, Burgundy, France 120

100% barrel aged Pinot Noir, 33% new oak. The nose presents well-defined red cherries, raspberry, underbrush and cold stone scents. The palate is fresh and crisp with high toned raspberry, black cherry, pepper and herbs with plenty of finesse and refinement towards the finish. Exquisite

'19 Turley, Duarte Vineyard, Contra Costa, California 81

Floral raspberry jam aromas lead to tightly focused cherry, sweet anise and pepper flavors that take on speed toward refined tannins. 1570 cases produced. Always Incredible

'12 Muret-Gaston, Cabernet Sauvignon, Red Mountain, Washington 88

Beautiful Washington State Cab! Cassis, dark black fruits, clove, savory and eucalyptus leaves unfold with each new sip, and then carry through the long finish on a platform of fine grained tannins. 28 months in new French Oak. The bomb

'14 Curvature, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California 110

From the owner & winemaker at Pride Mountain with pro golfer Kristy Kerr. Proceeds go to breast cancer research. 24 months in French Oak. 365 cases. Luxurious and delicate!

'15 Grassi, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California 120

Complex notes of black cherry, plum, lavender, menthol, chocolate, spice and leather please in this racy and luxurious Cabernet Sauvignon produced in vineyards just a mile south of the Stag's Leap District. Hedonistic
